Tournament to be on a handicap. 200 scratch for individuals. 4/5 of difference between average and scratch to be allowed with a max of 180 pins per event.

Bowlers must use averages bowled in Firemen's Tournament the last three calendar years.

New bowlers with USBC SANCTIONED average must report and use your highest average from last season or current season average 21 games min. at close of entries for first year. You will then use your Firemen's average next time you bowl in the tournament.

New bowlers with no average at all will be 150 with a handicap of 120 pins.

All entry fees will be held in trust in the name of the tournament and will be returned 100% in prizes plus trophies
